

Skylights Drop Two

The MSUN Skylights suffered through a cold-shooting weekend as they lost to Westminster (UT) 68-50 in Salt Lake and Lewis-Clark (ID) 67-51 in Lewiston.

Westminster led 31-22 at the half and got 30 points and 12 rebounds from 5-11 senior guard McKenzie Jessop. The Griffins (12-4, 1-0) picked up their 16th straight league win and made 9-20 shots from the three-point line and 25-52 from the floor.

MSUN held a 33-30 rebounding advantage but was able to connect on only 16-45 field goals for 35.6%.

Taylor Keller tallied 13 points for the Skylights and Zivile Gaizutyte added 10 points and 11 rebounds.

Lewis-Clark (16-2, 2-0) led 28-26 at the half before pulling away. The Skylights were 11-12 from the foul line in the first half but only 6/15 after intermission from the charity stripe.

MSUN out-rebounded Lewis-Clark 37-31 but shot only 32.6% from the floor (15-46) against the stingy Lady Warrior defense.

Gaizutyte led the Skylights with 11 points and 10 rebounds while Katie Kuntz, a junior from Wenatchee, WA added 10 points.

Kenna Reiter scored 16 points for Lewis-Clark and Jasmine Stohr added 14.
