LIBRARY SERVICES

The Vande Bogart Library is a modern air-conditioned building with areas for individual and group study. Collections include books, microforms, journals, U.S. Government Documents, Montana State Documents, maps, and photo archives. A photocopy machine, microform reader-printer, and a video viewing room with VHS & DVD players are available.

The Vande Bogart Library provides books, journals, and extensive electronic resources for students, faculty, staff and community members. The library staff is prepared to assist students in their research, and to order materials from other libraries for student and faculty use.

Students can access the library's catalog and electronic databases from any of the university's computer labs, as well as from the library's own public computer stations. Students in Havre or at distant sites who have Internet access at home or at work can also utilize the catalog and electronic databases from off campus by using a proxy account. To use the proxy, students will need to enter their Banner ID number and a password of their choice when prompted at the Library's Web pages. Students can obtain their Banner ID number by phoning the Registrar's Office at (406) 265-3703.

An assisted student computer lab and classrooms/labs are located in the lower level of the library. This area is also home to the Advising Center and the Learning Center.
