LIBRARY SERVICES

The Vande Bogart Library is a modern air-conditioned building with areas for individual and group study. Collections include books, microforms, journals, U.S. and Montana Government Documents, maps and photo archives. A photocopy machine, microform reader-printer, and a room with VHS & DVD players are available.

The Library provides books, journals, and extensive electronic resources for the use of students, faculty, staff and community members. The library staff is prepared to assist students with their research needs, and to request materials from other libraries for the students and faculty to use. Students are required to show a student ID card or MSUN receipt printed with their student ID number prior to checking out materials.

Students can access the library's catalog and electronic databases from any university computer. The Library offers wireless access for students wishing to use their own laptop. Students who are off campus or at distance sites can also utilize the catalog and electronic databases by using their proxy account. Contact the library staff with any questions.

An assisted student computer lab and classrooms/labs are located in the lower level of the library. This area is also home to the Advising Center and the Learning Center.
