Student Classifications:

Undergraduate	Student not possessing a Bachelor's Degree
Graduate	Student possessing a Bachelor's Degree or higher. All Graduate students must provide MSU-Northern with an official transcript from the institution where the Bachelor's Degree was earned.
Non-Traditional	Student having been out of high school 3 or more years and over the age of 21.
Traditional	Student having been out of high school less than 3 years and under the age of 21
Re-Admit	Student who has attended MSU-Northern or Northern Montana College in a regular semester/quarter (not Continuing Education)
New	Student who has never attended MSU-Northern
Degree Seeking	Student who plans to pursue a degree at MSU-Northern
Non-Degree Seeking	Student who does NOT plan to pursue a degree at MSU-Northern.
Transfer	Student who has taken course work at a college or university other than MSU-Northern. All transfer students must provide MSU-Northern with an official transcript from all institutions credit was earned.
QuickStart	<p>Student who wishes to enroll for university courses while concurrently enrolled in high school. Students are limited to 6 credits per semester. Student wishing to participate in this program must provide MSU-Northern with the following materials:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• letter of recommendation from the student's counselor or superintendent• SAT composite score of 930• ACT composite score of 20• GPA of 3.0• High School Transcript
