TRAFFIC EDUCATION

MSU-Northern offers education majors and current certified teachers the opportunity to earn a minor or an endorsement in traffic education. The core required courses (EDUC 361/561, EDUC 362/562, EDUC 365/565, HPE 234 and HPE 368/EDUC 557) are offered every summer. Completion of the first three listed courses will give currently certified educators the ground work necessary to begin working with their district traffic education programs. Earn a Master's Degree for Agency/Community Counseling and School Counseling on Weekends

The Counselor Education Master's of Education Program provides delivery of coursework over weekends—in Havre and Great Falls—to allow you to work full time and complete a master's degree from an accredited program. Classes meet Friday evenings and Saturdays throughout the fall and spring semester. During the summer, courses meet the entire weekend. Applicants for the counselor education degree, school counselor option, are not required to have K-12 classroom teaching experience.

The program supports a comprehensive master's degree that prepares you to meet the academic requirements to apply for licensure as a Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor and/or for an educator license as a School Counselor. The Counselor Education degree upholds the professional and ethical standards of the American Counseling Association and the American School Counseling Association.

As a graduate of our program, you will be prepared to bring about positive change at schools, universities, hospitals, mental health agencies, rehabilitation facilities, business and industry, correctional institutions, religious organizations, community centers, and in private practice.
