Montana State University-Northern has partnered with Virtual Education Software, inc. to offer continuing education courses for K-12 educators on CD-ROM. These interactive courses provide expert instruction at a pace that fits your schedule. These computer-based software courses are designed to be run from the compact disc (CD) and saves user data on the hard drive of the Macintosh or Windows computer being used. You need to begin and complete your course on the same computer.

Registration for all computer-based courses must be completed before June 6. All work must be completed by August 4, 2011. Instruction software with instruction package will be sent to students on CD. Cost is \$110 for computer software and instruction package plus tuition fee.
