These online courses will be delivered using Desire2Learn, our online course delivery tool. A Desire2Learn account will be established for you when your registration is processed. Although you won't be able to log into your course until seven days prior to the start of the class, it is critical that you access your Desire2Learn account for course-related materials by the first day of class. Log on to view the syllabus and become acquainted with Desire2Learn. Instructors may still be making changes to the course and may not have assignments ready for you until the first day of class.
