Several recruiters are scheduled after Spring Break. A sign-up sheet for interview times is available in the Career Center in Donaldson Hall.

Foundation Coal – March 20th. Interviews for both Co-op and full-time positions will take place in the Career Center. They are recruiting both diesel and automotive students.
