Christmas Tree Lighting



On Dec. 6, 2010 at noon, Northern held its annual Christmas tree lighting in front of the Registrar's office on the second floor of Cowan Hall. Former MSU-Northern Provost Dr. Joe Callahan was in town and joined Chancellor Frank Trocki to turn on the lights using Northern's traditional North Pole light switch.

MSU-Northern Signs MOU for Drone Research

MSU-Northern recently signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Mississippi State University, Montana State University in Bozeman and Rocky Mountain College in Billings to research the use of drones. The plan is to use the vast military operations area, or MOA, in Montana to research and test aerial drones. Northern will be the administrative arm of the center, along with doing research on some aspects including the production of biofuels for the drones. The engineering department at MSU would be doing the majority of the research, with the aviation programs at Rocky Mountain College handling the aviation aspect. The research center will apply to the military for permission to test the drones in the Montana MOA. Northern plans to apply for a grant to pay for a feasibility study for the project. Once a feasibility study is completed, the next step would be to ask the FAA to include the research project as a Center of Excellence to research, study and monitor the issue.


Graduation Applications Due

Word Tip

Display a table heading across multiple pages

If a table extends beyond a page, or across several pages, you might want to display the table's header row at the top of each page. Here are two ways to do this in Word 2007/2010:

- 1. Click inside the table,
- 2. click the Layout tab.
- 3. click the down arrow in the Data group and select Repeat Header Rows.

Or...

- 1. Select the table (by clicking the crossed arrows at the top left of the table)
- 2. Right click then select Table Properties
- 3. On the Row tab, check the Repeat as header row at top of each page box.
