#### **Cree Mini Lessons Part 2**



In celebration of Native American Heritage Month, the Little River Institute hosted the second part of their interactive "lunch and learn" Cree language and culture lessons with Kishey Pisim Baker. Kishey was born and raised in Saskatchewan, Canada, with Cree as her first language. She has lived in Rocky Boy, Montana, for more than 20 years with her spouse, their three children and one stepson. Kishey holds a B.S.Ed. in elementary education from MSU-N. After a number of years teaching at Box Elder Schools,

Kishey enrolled in MSU-N's Master of Education degree in counselor education. In Wednesday's session, Kishey shared Cree kinship explaining the relationships between mothers and fathers, brothers and sisters, and aunt and uncles among Cree families. She shared the meaning of the Cree medicine wheel and the connection to her philosophy of counseling in helping people find emotional and physiological healing. In addition, she shared traditional clothing that she made and the connection to her family and tribe. She also demonstrated traditional dance styles inviting the participants to join her. We are honored to have Kishey support the efforts of the Little River Institute in promoting cultural awareness and understanding of our regional tribes.


