# ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN NURSING

## I. SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM

Montana State University - Northern (MSUN) and Stone Child College (SCC) hereby establish an articulation agreement leading to an Associate of Science Degree in Nursing. The degree will be conferred by MSUN.

#### II. LENGTH OF AGREEMENT

This agreement will begin fall semester 2011. The parties commit to a review every other year. The next review will be spring semester 2013.

#### III. COURSE ARTICULATION

Students completing the **Associate of Applied Science Degree in Allied Health** at SCC will be granted 27 semester credits toward an Associate of Science degree in Nursing at MSUN. Upon completion of the following program courses as shown in **Exhibit A** and the meeting of all graduation requirements, an Associate of Science degree in Nursing will be awarded. 72 semester credits are required. **Exhibit B** provides an overview of degree equivalencies.

## V. ADMISSIONS POLICY AND REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements for MSUN are as follows:

1) Completed MSUN Application for Admission

2) \$30 non-refundable "one-time" application fee

3) In order to be in compliance with Montana state law, all degree seeking students or students carrying more than seven (7) credits, who are born on or after January 1, 1957 must show proof of two vaccinations against measles and one against rubella; "or" show documentation from a physician with dates of illness of having contracted measles and rubella; "or" file a notarized medical or religious exemption.

4) An official academic transcript from all accredited universities, colleges, and vocational technical centers attended. (Official college transcripts must be sent to the

Admissions Office in a sealed envelope directly from the institution.)

 Students transferring to MSUN must have a minimum cumulative transferable grade point average of 2.0 from all colleges or universities previously attended.

# VI. PREREQUISITES FOR ENTERING THE NURSING PROGRAM

To be considered for admission to Nursing the student must:

 be admitted to Montana State University-Northern (a separate application to the University is required; obtain form from the Admissions Office)

submit official copies of all university transcripts to Montana State University-Northern except those transcripts from MSU-Northern. Transcripts will be evaluated to determine credit allotment and articulation. No course requirement, including basic skills courses, will be waived simply on the basis that the applicant has a prior college degree.

have at least a 2.75 extracted GPA in the following required pre-nursing courses: College Algebra, Anatomy & Physiology I, Anatomy and Physiology II, Written Communications II, Nutrition, General Inorganic Chemistry, Introduction to Nursing and Introduction to Psychology. A grade of C or above is required. A grade of C- in any prenursing course requires the course be retaken.

not have failed a required program course more than two (2) times in the last five (5) years. Failure of more than two (2) program required courses in the last five (5) years

results in the student being ineligible for admission to the Nursing program.



### VII. FINANCIAL AID

All enrolled students are eligible to apply for financial aid at MSUN. Each student's situation will be evaluated on an individual basis. Students must apply for financial assistance through MSUN's Financial Aid Office.
