1. Announcements

Riley – Student Senate inducted 9 new members, and will maintain the same executive team. Created a new position: food pantry coordinator. Have not received any official feedback from students about the semester, positive or negative. Anecdotally, students with lab courses are struggling but finding ways to cope.

Cindy – CARES Act update: OCHE has omitted language directing campuses to use 20% of the funding in the spring, 20% in the summer, and keep 60% in reserve for fall. Still requiring that students fill out an application to receive funds (Northern will have 627 eligible students). Will coordinate with the other MSU campuses and submit a final plan to OCHE.

Good news: award letters for fall are going out, traffic is picking up.

Chancellor – MSUN's Covid-19 response has been on par or ahead of the rest of the university system. Staying apprised of the situation across the state and federally. New cases in Montana remain low, indicating we have done our job in flattening the curve. As we begin re-opening in phases, we will be proactive but we will also be smart, and do what makes sense. We intend to provide face to face courses in the fall and are discussing various scenarios on how best to implement that. Also looking at various scenarios for athletics.
