This weekends showings of The Glass Menagerie have been cancelled due to illness. Sorry for the inconvenience. These shows will not be rescheduled.



# **#BuckleUpBlue4Lauryn (Pat Goldhahn) Presentation – Jan 31**

On August 25, 2016, fifteen-year-old Lauryn Goldhahn was thrown 150ft from a pickup after it rolled two and a half times and hit a power pole. On August 27, she was pronounced dead. Lauryn was not wearing a seatbelt.

On January 31, her father, Pat Goldhahn, will share the details of the accident that caused the death of his daughter, their family's journey through grief, organ donation, and the #BuckleUpBlue4Lauryn ribbon campaign. 
