Twenty-Seven Students Inducted into National Society of Leadership and Success

The NSLS is the nation's largest leadership honor society. "It was great to see so many outstanding students join our inaugural NSLS cohort. They invested a great deal of time and effort, and I could not be more proud of each newly inducted member," said Kris Bruckerhoff, NSLS chapter advisor.

Students are selected by their college for membership based on either academic standing or leadership potential. MSU-Northern is one of only three schools in Montana who are part of this outstanding honor society.

In addition to honorable distinction, the NSLS provides a step-by-step program for members to build their leadership skills through participation on their campus or online. Upon completion of the program, members receive their leadership certificate and take their place among the top student leaders at their campus and across the country. Members are able to list their affiliation on all statements of personal accomplishment, including their resume.

Just in case you were wondering, Vacaville, California, is only about 114 miles from Gilroy California.


Did you know that Northern quarterback, Brenden Medina, had 389 passing yards against Carroll College on September 21 -- the highest single game total this year in the Frontier Conference? The Northern record is 532 yards by Derek Lear in 2012.

In addition, Northern punter, Hunter Riley, had the Frontier Conference longest punt this year at 78 yards on September 7 at Rocky Mountain College. Don Saisbury set the previous Northern record in 2007.
