The Northern Foundation is proud to announce that the loan for the Lights Football field has been paid in full. In a celebratory moment this week, campus and community leaders gathered at Tilleman Field for a ceremonial check presentation, marking the official payoff of the \$1.69 million project. A total of just over \$3 million was raised for this project.

Looking ahead, the next phase of campus life and athletic development will be the construction of a new recreation center on the south side of Tilleman Field, which will also include new home bleachers for Lights fans. This facility will continue to enhance the student and fan experience while further strengthening the connection between MSU-Northern and the Hi-Line community.

MSU-Northern Hosted STEM Summer Institute Program



MSU-Northern, in partnership with Fort Peck Community College hosted the 2025 Summer STEM Institute from August 4-7, 2025 at Northern. This

workshop brought together fifteen K-12 educators from Poplar, Wolf Point, Brockton, and Frazer, for hands-on place-based science, technology, engineering, and math training. Funded through the Minority Science and Engineering Improvement Program (MSEIP), the workshop aimed to strengthen STEM education through collaborative research, fieldwork, and culturally responsive teaching strategies.

Participants explored the Bear Paw Mountain's unique geology, performed water flow analyses, studied invertebrates in Beaver Creek, and created spectroscopes and solar cars in the lab. The institute featured keynotes from Rod Benson (retired Harlem Science Teacher; NMC 1981) and Teresa Olson (Retired Rocky Boy Science Teacher; NMC 1996) who shared innovative approaches to making STEM accessible and engaging in the classroom.

Northern Lights Up the Night at 5th Annual Aurora Borealis Festival

Diesel Golf Scramble Powered Up Over \$9.5K for MSU-Northern




Wet Willy: A Welcome Week Favorite!


