Why should faculty and students use Kanopy?

The library pays for this ~\$2,800 annual subscription to ~10,000 streaming videos via a consortium agreement with TRAILS (Treasure State Academic Information & Library Services)

- Documentaries by subject area (Applied Sciences, Medicine, DEI) to personal development skills (Mental Health, Nutrition, and Fitness)
- Criterion Collection
- Feature films

91% of faculty say including streaming video and other digital media in course materials improves student outcomes*

- Encourage open discussion on key issues
- Embed video clips into LMS (D2L) see <u>library tutorials</u> on <u>library's homepage</u> and select "Kanopy"
- Save favorite videos to watchlists

- Utilize video as foundational and supplementary material for research papers and presentations
- Follow up and explore on a professor's videoclips by watching the full video
- Cite videos and export in up-to-date MLA, CMS, and APA formats
