Donaldson Long Term Plan	Potential for 57 resident rooms, grossing a potential revenue of \$342,000 per
	year. The tentative price for a room would be \$6,000 per year for a single. The

	and have higher ceilings. There are currently 35-40 juniors and seniors on
	campus; they make up 25% of the total population on campus. A new
	committee was established; Hannah Pate (chair), Steve Wise, Collin Miller,
	Hannah Rutherford, Chris Brekke-George, and Jaycene Windy Boy. The
	committee that was established will begin looking for grants to help fund the
	project, will continue to look into what we can do with the space, and will

Jeremy Hofman Letter of Support	Chris Brekke presented a letter of support for Jeremy Hofman, COTS faculty member whose contract is not being renewed because he did not continue to work on obtaining a master's degree. Chris stressed the fallowing attributes: up to date on new equipment, gets people involved on campus, faculty members look up to him, teaches theory, good teacher, he is involved on campus, and great advisor. Chris talked about how COTS cannot afford to lose him, presented personal testimonies, and talked about him bringing in equipment for the department. Dr. Moisey responded in saying that he is in violation of his contract and how he will be able to teach next semester. Dr. Moisey wants to maintain standards for faculty members and BOR dictates minimum faculty standards. He also stressed the quality of academic principles at Northern. Dr. Moisey said there are fallacies within the letter of support, but he could not discuss it because of confidentiality. Amber Spring recommended his students stress to him, his importance and ask that he reenroll in a master's program. M. Tackitt moved the letter be sent to Exec and students push Hofman to pursue a master's degree within the state of MT. Motion seconded, and passed.
