Dodge spoke about the divided living community on campus, strict rules, harsh security measures; RD's who are not students, and discrimination against students trying to enter the dorms. George (Morgan RD) treated a club on campus rudely during first meeting in Morgan Red Room. All of these concerns were said in front of Steve. He responded by saying that safety is the number 1 concern. He needs more RA coverage to secure the building, need to control the points of entry into the buildings. He will look into allowing fobs to work for both buildings; he will not unlock doors to buildings during business hours, and will not change any security measures put in place at this point. Erik brought up the SFH needs deadbolts if we are going to be talking about security on this campus. Doors and windows in SFH are not secure and residents are commenting on the need for more security up there. Hannah P. moved for cloture, seconded, passed.
