Call to order: Quorum Established; Meeting called to order by C. Brekke-George at 7:00pm

A. Lankford said he would like to see the community based social events come back, community building to happen, and for ASMSUN to be more involved with programs and orientation. He would like us to bring in team building activities, improve recruitment practices, and the town hall meetings we have done in the past. He would like committee

chairs to outline goals for their committees, as well as keeping regular meeting times. In addition, the engine blow up needs to come back.

J. Copenhaver stated we should try to do a leadership summit with ASMSUN, Ambassadors, and Faculty members. ASMSUN should consider doing a lock in at the library at the beginning of the year.

H. Pate stated she would like to see more student voices in our meetings, parliamentary procedures to be followed in meetings, and more liberal arts representation on senate. She also would like to see ASMSUN adopt more modern communication methods. She said ASMSUN should hold leadership trainings and possibly a senate retreat every year. Overall, she would like to see more participation, involvement, and commitment to ASMSUN.
